Liaise with local and national media – press, web etc.

Communicate results of every game immediately

Keep up-to-date on the latest happenings in the squad

Give brief verbal reports of matches and interviews where necessary

Write detailed reports of matches

Oversee the club archive of records and photos

How much time it will take up:

Around 1-2 hours a week depending on the status of the squad.

What you'll get out of it:

You'll be the voice of the squad; its profile is under your watchful eye. As the person with the lowdown on matches and other club activity, you'll make lots of new contacts in the sports and journalism arenas, raising your own profile by association. The more you involve people in the club, the more you'll get out of the role.
